Take a ride on one of the few horse-drawn trams remaining in public transport anywhere in the world. [www.horsedrawntram.com.au]


7. Admirals Arch

Take a tour to see the Murray River and book a ride on the PS Murray Princess. [www.murrayriver.com.au]


15. Toy Factory – Gumeracha
